Here is some basic information about us

Harbourside Cohousing opened in January 2016 after five years of planning and development. Our focus is on flourishing in community in the second half of life. Our strata---titled community on the Sooke waterfront includes 31 compact homeowner units (ave size 845 sq ft) and about 4,000 sq ft of common space, mostly in a converted resort building. Our construction achieved Built Green Canada's Gold standard of energy efficiency.

Our mission is to be a sustainable senior cohousing homeowner community that promotes healthy aging in place. The physical structures as well as the social fabric of our community nurture an innovative culture with lively connections to the larger society. While respecting personal privacy, we foster cooperation, social connection and affordability through design and through mutual support.
